We wanted to take the opportunity to share with you all the steps we are taking to fight against Covid-19. We want everyone to feel comfortable to visit us. Your health, safety and enjoyment are our top priority.

WE ARE:

Re-arranging (and in some cases removing) tables from our bar and restaurant to make it easier for you to social distance.

Providing automatic hand sanitisers at multiple points throughout the pub

Providing new personal hygiene facilities in the toilets

Introducing a 'one way' system throughout the pub to reduce the number of close contacts that may occur during your visit.

Using signage to make our rules clear and easy to follow so you can feel more at ease during your visit

Training our staff to habitually wash and sanitise their hands (as well as after tasks when hand washing and sanitising would have normally been required).

Training our staff to habitually wipe and sanitise common points of personal contact such as bars, tables, chairs.

Implementing stricter and more regular cleaning checks of our toilet facilities.

Introducing a 'Host' who will help guide you on your visit

Strongly encouraging the use of masks for those who come within 1 metre to serve you

Installing screens at common points of contact and service on our bar

Implementing a "buddy" or team method for staffing which will limit the number of different people you come into contact with.

Limiting the overall number of staff on shift at any time.

Limiting the amount of guests we can accommodate at any one time.

Not allowing standing or loitering in the bar or restaurant areas.

Keeping you up to date with all the changes and procedures at The White Horse by regularly updating our social media channels and webpage.

Allocating tables for guests what ever their needs.

Staggering arrival times of booked guest to prevent large crowds from forming.

Limiting our maximum table size to prevent large crowds from forming.

Developing our outside areas so we can more effectively use outside space.
